5 MR. ANZ: Basically just in follow-up on this that  
6 the, our feeling for the nonsuit being the improper result  
7 was that at the trial all we had asked for, and I believe  
8 the confusion stemmed from defendant's attack what was  
9 asked for, was the specific declarations. We were not  
10 asking for the Court to order the relief that the  
11 declarations would state.

12 For example, we asked for the reading that the  
13 documents that were presented to the Court gave plaintiffs  
14 or parishioners of the church a right to seek an  
15 accounting, that that was an inherent right that they held.

16 The controversy existed in that we believe  
17 defendants denied that we had that right or any of the  
18 other matters requested.

19 We did not ask the Court to order an  
20 accounting, but that to vest us with what the documents had  
21 inherently given us because outside of the courts giving us  
22 that declaration, the church and defendants had sort of  
23 entrenched themselves behind the veil of ecclesiastic  
24 authority and had refused to sort of come out from that.  
25 And that the Court's declarations would sort of shed light  
26 on these matters.
